BYLAWS

PREAMBLE:

The Rocky Mountain Yeomen is a recreational archery club. We strive to create an environment in which all students of the Rocky Mountain west are able to participate, enjoy, and excel in the sport of archery.

PURPOSE:

It is the purpose of the Bylaws to clarify any procedural issues.

MEMBERSHIP:

- a. Membership is granted to all interested individuals without discrimination because of age, disability, gender, marital status, national origin, race, religion, or skill level.

DUES:

- a. Club members who participate in club events must pay dues of \$12.00 per year prorated to January 1st.
- b. Dues will be handled by the organization's Secretary/Treasurer and deposited in the club's bank account.

OFFICERS:

- a. Shall fulfill requirements as outlined in the Constitution.

OFFICER DUTIES:

a. President

- i. Shall be responsible for the well-being and good standing of the entire organization.
- ii. Shall be responsible for overseeing all other positions.
- iii. Shall be responsible for ensuring a safe environment and behavior at all times.
- iv. Shall have any other duties not explicitly mentioned.

b. Safety Officer

- i. Shall assist the President

- ii. Shall have any other duties not explicitly mentioned.

b. Vice-President

- i. Shall assist the President.
- iv. Shall have any other duties not explicitly mentioned.

c. Secretary/Treasurer

- i. Shall assist the President with financial matters.
- ii. Keeps track of dues, income, and disbursements.
- iii. Keeps track of club spending and ensures there are no over-drafts
- iv. Always knows the exact amount of money the club has.

AMENDMENTS:

- a. Amendments to the Bylaws may be proposed to the Officers.
- b. It is the responsibility of the Officers to review and maintain the Bylaws. Amendments will require a 66-2/3 percent Officers vote.
- c. In the event of a tie, the President shall act as tiebreaker.
- d. All Officers must be present at the meeting when dealing with amendments to the Bylaws.
