ARTICLE I. Preamble

These rules apply to all members of the Rocky Mountain Yeomen (RMY).

ARTICLE I. Purpose.

The purpose of this Honor Code is to provide guidelines for members of the RMY.

ARTICLE II. Scope and Jurisdiction.

The Officers shall hear and to determine charges of inappropriate behavior, stealing, or vandalism by any member of the RMY.

ARTICLE III. Prohibited Conduct.

Violations of the Honor Code include the following acts and knowing assistance in such acts:

Section 1: Inappropriate Behavior.

Inappropriate behavior may include, but not be limited to harassment (for example: using words or actions that intimidate, threaten, disparage, or persecute others before, during or following any RMY activity), failure to follow rules, or abusive behavior.

Section 2. Stealing.

Stealing is the intentional taking or appropriating the property of another without right or leave and with intent to keep or make use of it wrongfully.

Section 3. Vandalism

Vandalism is the act of destroying or defacing any material or property owned by or in the custody a member of the RMY.
